- To be eligible for Colorado State Championship medals you must hold a current CO annual USAC license and be a USA citizen or permanent resident. Additionally, to receive the Colorado State Champion vest you must be a current CO annual member of BRAC. Professional men and women are welcome to race, but are not eligible for State Championship title, medal or vest.
- Categories with "*" are Masters State Championships Races
- All categories are eligible for BRAC Rocky Mtn CUP Gold Points except SM 5
- Registration Tent will be located at the race course on the Corner of Hwy 291 and County Road 156 - look for the Scanga Meat sign.
- Top 3 in each race will receive a Rocky Mountain State Games medal

Registration Headquarters for the Time Trial and Criterium will be located at Alpine Park (4th and "F" Streets) downtown Salida. Registration will be moved to the Road Race on Sunday (corner of HWY 291 and CR 156). You must pre-register online for the Time Trial. Onsite registration **CLOSES 1 HOUR PRIOR TO THE START OF THE CRITERIUM AND ROAD RACE**. Fees: \$120 for entry for all three events (you must sign up for all three online to receive this rate). Individual event fees: Time Trial \$35 (NO onsite registration); Criterium \$45 (\$55 onsite) and \$10 for 2nd race; and Road Race \$50 (\$60 onsite). Junior Fee: \$20 for each event and \$50 for all three events. **Junior Scholarship Program:** a limited number of scholarships will be available to help cover the cost of registration fees for Juniors. For more information, please contact salidaclassic@gmail.com. All registration fees include a \$5.50 surcharge for USAC and ACA.

Notes: Time Trial and Road Race courses will not be completely closed to traffic. Do not drive or warm up on the courses.
Time Trial and Criterium results will be posted at Alpine Park. Road Race results will be posted at the Road Race.

USAC 1-Day license: \$15, only avail. onsite for Cat 5 M, Cat 4 W who have never had a previous license with a higher category. Annual licenses avail. online at www.usacycling.org. - BRAC annual membership recommended to avoid BRAC 1-Day membership (\$5) on race day. (BRAC 1-Day Membership exempt with USAC 1-Day). Annual Memberships available online www.coloradocycling.org. - BRAC High-Speed Cameras and Timing System will be in use. GEAR RESTRICTIONS apply to all Juniors 9-18. See USAC Rule 114. BIKE RESTRICTIONS apply to Juniors 14 & under. See USAC Rule 115.
